

OUR PARENT/CARER CHARTER

BeBright Pre School is built upon positive, clear family values and as a setting we are wholly committed to supporting children and families during their time at BeBright.

We actively promote the expectations detailed in our charter every day at BeBright Pre School with our clear pre school aims and what we deem as acceptable conduct from all adults, children and partners that we come into contact with on a daily basis.

Democracy

At BeBright Pre School every child is actively encouraged to have a voice and demonstrate a sense of self. This is achieved through various forms including verbal and non verbal methods of voting for their desired outcome. Every child should feel valued and we will ensure that this is promoted during their time with us.

We encourage children to understand their own and others behaviour and its consequences to help distinguish right from wrong. We work alongside the children to create rules and pre school expectations that everyone should work together to implement the rules such as helping to tidy up, using gentle hands and kind words.

We provide opportunities for children to develop the self knowledge, self esteem and increase their confidence in their own abilities, for example the children are encouraged to manage their own risk when exploring the climbing equipment in the garden. We implement and encourage a range of experiences that allow the children to explore the language of feelings and responsibility, reflect on their differences and understand everyone is free to have different opinions.

We create an ethos of inclusivity and tolerance where faith, cultures and races are valued and celebrated. We provide resources and activities that challenge gender, cultural and racial stereotyping.

We want to work in partnership with you to ensure that your child makes the most of their learning at BeBright Pre School.



Ensure your child comes to the setting on their booked sessions as much as possible to ensure a routine is kept for your child; is punctual and collected on time. This will give your child the best opportunity to achieve.

Make sure BeBright Pre School is aware of any concerns that may affect your child's learning opportunities and wellbeing at the earliest opportunity.

All forms of communication should be polite and courteous including face to face, over the telephone and via email or messages.

Attend Parent/Carer meetings and discussions about your child's progress.

Take an interest in your child's participation in preschool life.

Support and encourage your child to follow the preschool ethos of respect and inclusion.

Keep BeBright Pre School informed of any changes of address or contact numbers.

To familiarise your self with key policies and procedures of BeBright Pe School.



We will encourage your child to do their absolute best and achieve their full potential as a valid member of the preschool community.

We provide a child led, balanced, creative, and varied curriculum to meet the individual needs of your child.

We will model courteous, polite, and respectful behaviour whilst at BeBright Pre School and have high expectations of the children to always behave politely and respectfully to each other and other adults. We ensure that your child's wellbeing and safety is always of paramount importance.

We promise to inform you of your child's progress at regular intervals.

We offer you opportunities for you to be involved in the daily life of BeBright Pre School. We will be open and honest with you and actively listen to issues, endeavour to provide an agreeable solution to both parties and inform both parties of the outcomes.

We will take an act upon legal advice where appropriate.

If there is a breakdown in the parent/carer charter and we believe the working relationship with the family has broken down, we reserve the right to de register your child's place with us by giving 4 weeks' notice.
